■ Requirements: Applicants must be 16 years old or more; mid- or long-term resident of Japan (already holding a residence card and staying in Japan)

■ How to apply: Fill in the relevant application form and submit a photograph

■ Level: From Beginner to Advanced

[Beginner] Acquire minimum level of proficiency to live in Japan.

[Elementary] Everyday conversation level. Ability to understand basic grammar and express simple ideas.

[Intermediate] No troubles in everyday conversation. Growth of personal vocabulary. Proficiency level allows the speaker to attend a Vocational school.

[Advanced] No troubles in conversation with native speakers. Proficiency allows the speaker to attempt a university entrance exam.

School events & Exams :

- Every 3 months of the course there are field trips and/or school events. Also, in the final period of the course, we will hold the presentation event of the classwork's.
- Students take an achievement test every week, and an end of term test at the end of the course.

Certificate : With a minimum attendance rate of 80%, students receive a completion certificate at the end of the course.

II. Cancellation Policy

[Cancellation before the course starts]

Any cancellation request must be submitted in written form (email).

The school replies to all messages, therefore please kindly double-check in case there is no answer from the school's side. Once paid, the registration fee cannot be refunded. For cancellations after the course has started, the following cancellation charges apply, regardless of the reason. Bank fees related to tuition refund are at receiver's charge.
